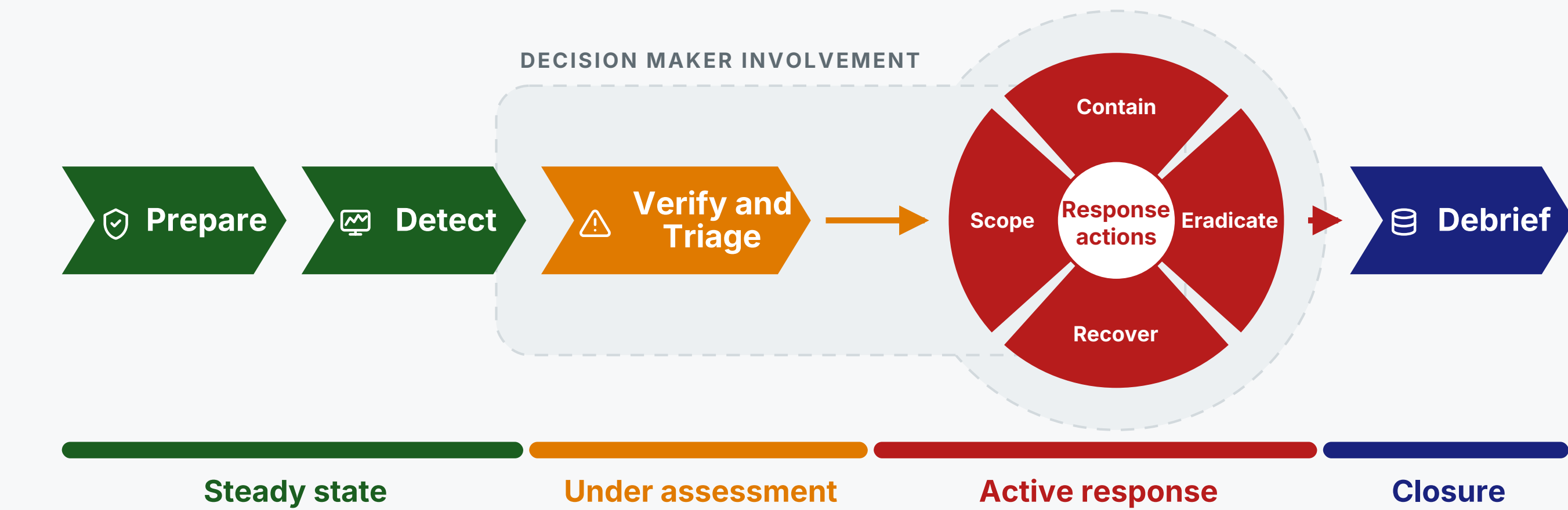


The Incident Response Lifecycle

The source figure, unaltered.

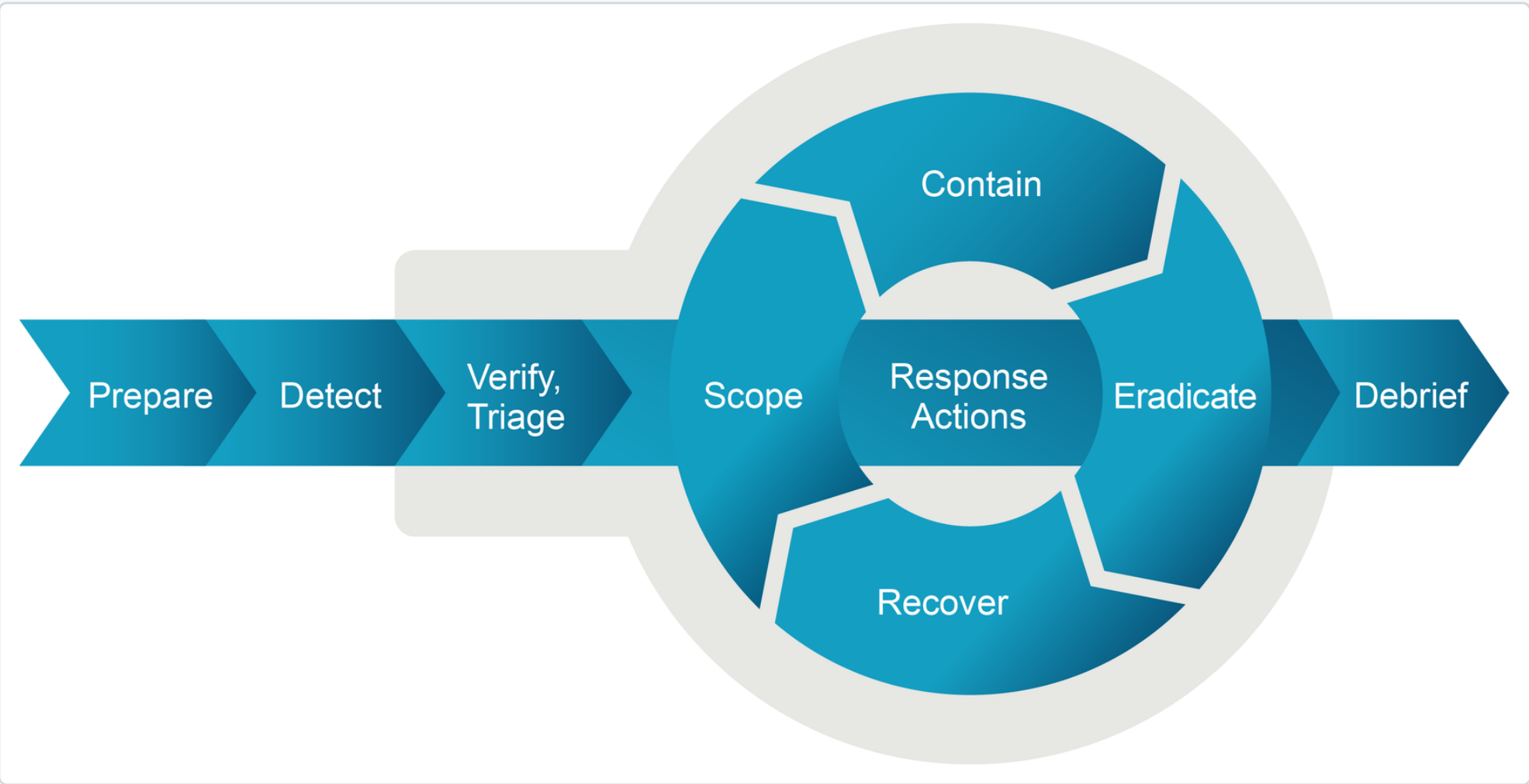
